Product Details

A range of penetrating wood preservatives based on powerful fungicide and insecticide for use against wood destroying fungi (including dry rot) and wood destroying insects.

Active ingredients: Permethrin 0.186%,

Propiconazole 0.93%. This product is registered with

the HSE (product registration 10089).

PLEASE NOTE:

Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative Gold Star is a new product, the colours in this range may not match older versions of the Blackfriar Goldstar Wood Preservative - Please ensure when multiple cans are used for a project they are from the Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative Gold Star range.

PREPARATION - Shake container vigorously prior to use. Ensure wood is clean, dry and free from surface contamination. If wood is not dry Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative Gold Star will not be able to penetrate and performance may be affected.

APPLICATION - Product is applied by brush and spray only (see precautions). Apply 1 litre of product per 3-8 square metres of timber surface. Do not dilute.

ERADICATION OF WET ROT

Remove source of dampness. Cut away all decayed timber and replace affected timber with sound timber treated with Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative

Gold Star. Also apply Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative Gold Star to surrounding timber areas.

ERADICATION OF DRY ROT

Remove source of dampness. Remove all affected wood and hack off all affected plaster, stonework etc. back to one metre beyond the attack. Sterilise all infected areas, walls, ground etc. Replace affected timber with sound timber treated with Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative Gold Star. Also apply Blackfriar Exterior Wood Preservative Gold Star to surrounding timber areas.

WOOD BORING INSECTS

Apply 1 litre of product per 3-8 square metres of timber surface. Apply by brush or spray. Do not dilute.

Drying Time BLACKFRIAR EXTERIOR WOOD PRESERVATIVE GOLD STAR WILL BE DRY WITHIN 24 HOURS UNDER GOOD DRYING CONDITIONS. DRYING TIME MAY BE PROLONGED IN COLD, DAMP WEATHER. ALLOW TO DRY THOROUGHLY BEFORE OVERCOATING.

For exterior applications the Clear must be overcoated with an Exterior Grade Wood Finish. The Coloured Wood Preservative is not suitable for application to garden furniture or any areas where colour transfer would be an issue.

Clean Up – Reseal container after use. Remove as much product as possible from equipment before washing with white spirit.
